Section 16(A) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Various Temporary Traffic Measures (Cycle Wiltshire Grand Prix): Various Roads, South Wiltshire (Ref: TTRO 4233)

Notice is hereby given that the Wiltshire Council has made an Order to close temporarily to all vehicular traffic:

- a) C369 (Part) Blue Boar Row, Salisbury; from its junction with C369 Minster Street to its junction with C369 Winchester Street.

Alternative route: via Castle Street – Scots Lane – Endless Street – Salt Lane – Rollestone Street – Brown Street – Milford Street – New Canal – High Street – Silver Street – Minster Street.

- b) C329 (Part) Fisherton Street, Salisbury; from its junction with A36 St. Paul's Roundabout to its junction with Bridge Street.

And to close temporarily to all traffic under a rolling road closure:

- c) Footpath 66, (The Market Place), Salisbury; for its entire length (alternative routes will be available via Footpaths 60, 67 and 68 around the perimeter of the Market Place).
- d) C370 (Part) Queen Street, Salisbury; from its junction with Blue Boar Row to its junction with New Canal.
- e) C329 (Part) New Canal, Salisbury; from its junction with Queen Street to its junction with High Street.
- f) C369 Winchester Street (Part), Salisbury; from its junction with Blue Boar Row / Queen Street to its junction with Brown Street.
- g) C369 (Part) Brown Street, Salisbury; from its junction with Winchester Street to its junction with St. Ann Street.
- h) C369 St. Ann Street (Part), Salisbury; from its junction with Brown Street to its junction with North Walk.
- i) North Walk, Salisbury; from its junction with St. Ann Street to its junction with Choristers Square.
- j) Choristers Square (Part), Salisbury; from its junction with North Walk to its junction with High Street.
- k) High Street (Part), Salisbury; from its junction with Choristers Square to its junction with New Street.
- l) C369 (Part) High Street, Salisbury; from its junction with New Street to its junction with Bridge Street.
- m) C329 (Part) Bridge Street / Fisherton Street, Salisbury; from its junction with High Street to its junction with A36 Wilton Road Roundabout.

The section of the A36 between Salisbury and Wilton will be covered by a separate Traffic Order made by Highways England.

- n) A30 (Part) Minster Street / Kingsbury Square / Silver Street, Wilton; from its junction with A36 Salisbury Street Roundabout to its junction with C63 South Street.
- o) A30 (Part) Wilton, Burcombe Without, Barford St Martin, Compton Chamberlayne and Fovant; from its junction with C63 South Street, Wilton to its junction with C64 Fovant Road, Fovant.
- p) C64 (Part) Fovant Road, Fovant and Ebbesbourne Wake; from its junction with A30 to its junction with C12 Fifield Bavant.
- q) C12 (Part) Fifield Bavant, Ebbesbourne Wake, Broad Chalke and Bishopstone; from its junction with C64 Fovant Road to its junction with C63 Portfield Road, Bishopstone.
- r) C63 (Part) Portfield Road, Bishopstone/South Street, Wilton; from its junction with C12 Bishopstone to its junction with A30 Wilton.
- s) C12 (Part), Bishopstone / Stratford Tony; from its junction with C63 Portfield Road to its junction with C320 (Crossroads at Manor Farm).
- t) C320 (Crossroads at Manor Farm), Stratford Tony / The Strip, Netherhampton; from its junction with C12 Stratford Tony to its junction with A3094 Netherhampton.
- u) A3094 (Part) Netherhampton / Quidhampton; from its junction with C320 The Strip to its junction with A36 Wilton Road.

The section of the A36 between the junction of A3094 and St. Paul's Roundabout, Salisbury will be covered by a separate Traffic Order made by Highways England.

- v) C329 (Part) Fisherton Street, Salisbury; from its junction with A36 St. Paul's Roundabout to its junction with C329 Bridge Street.
- w) C329 (Part) Bridge Street, Salisbury; from its junction with C329 Fisherton Street to its junction with C369 Silver Street.
- x) C369 (Part) Silver Street, Salisbury; from its junction with C329 Bridge Street to its junction with C369 Minster Street.
- y) C369 (Part) Minster Street, Salisbury; from its junction with C369 Silver Street to its junction with C369 Blue Boar Row.
- z) C369 (Part) Blue Boar Row, Salisbury; from its junction with C369 Minster Street to its junction with C369 Winchester Street.
- aa) C369 Winchester Street (Part), Salisbury; from its junction with C369 Blue Boar Row to its junction with Brown Street.

And to implement temporary No Waiting at Any Time restrictions on:

- bb) Market Place, Salisbury; from its junction with C369 Blue Boar Row for its entire area.

- cc) C369 (Part) Blue Boar Row, Salisbury (both sides of highway); from its junction with C369 Minster Street to its junction with C369 Winchester Street (including bus stops, disabled parking spaces and loading bays).
- dd) C329 Fisherton Street (Part), Salisbury (north-east side of highway); from its junction with St. Paul's Road in a south-easterly direction for the extent of the four parking bays.
- ee) C329 Fisherton Street (Part), Salisbury (south side of highway); for a distance of approximately 30m opposite The United Reformed Church covering the extent of the taxi bays.
- ff) C329 Fisherton Street (Part), Salisbury (south side of highway); for a distance of approximately 30m opposite The Slug and Lettuce Public House covering the extent of the bus stop.
- gg) C329 Fisherton Street (Part), Salisbury (north side of highway); for a distance of approximately 30m outside of The United Reformed Church.
- hh) C329 Fisherton Street (Part), Salisbury (north side of highway); for a distance of approximately 30m outside of The Slug and Lettuce Public House covering the extent of the loading bays.
- ii) C329 Silver Street (Part), Salisbury (south side of highway); for a distance of approximately 30m opposite St. Thomas' Church covering the extent of the disabled parking bays and loading bays.
- jj) C369 Minster Street (Part), Salisbury (west side of highway); for a distance of approximately 40m covering the extent of the disabled parking bays, loading bays and taxi bays.
- kk) C63 South Street (Part), Wilton (both sides of highway); from its junction with A30 West Street in a southerly direction to its junction with Bulbridge Road.

These temporary traffic measures are required to safeguard members of the public and competitors whilst enabling the Cycle Wiltshire Grand Prix 2016 to take place.

Temporary road closures (a) to (aa) will come into force on Sunday 8th May 2016 with the exception of vehicles officially involved in the cycle race, vehicles being used for ambulance, police or fire brigade purposes, or the purpose of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, or with permission being given by a Police Constable in uniform.

Part (a) will be effective between the hours of 05.00 and 18.00, and part (b) will be effective for a period of 60 minutes between 14.00 and 17.00. Parts (c) to (aa) will be effective between the hours of 10.00 and 18.00 (as a rolling road closure).

Parking restrictions (bb) to (kk) will come into force on Sunday 8th May 2016.

Parking restrictions (bb), (cc) and (kk) will be effective between the hours of 05.00 and 18.00. Parking restrictions (dd), (ii) and (jj) will be effective between the hours of 06.00 and 18.00, and parking restrictions (ee), (ff), (gg) and (hh) will be effective between the hours of 13.00 and 16.30.

The rolling closures will be implemented and managed on site by appropriate signing and Police motorcycle outriders who will close roads as required and assist the cycle peleton

around the race route consisting of six laps of closures (o) to (r). Closure (a) is required to facilitate a safe spectator area in Salisbury City Centre. For further information please contact Mr. Simon Lillistone, Fortitude Sports Consulting Ltd (on behalf of Wiltshire Council) on 07941 464227.
