**14/029. Highway issues.**

**(i) Safety issues along Lower Rd between Footshill and Skew Rd junctions.**

Clerk has spoken to Highways who suggested this is delayed until after the outcome of the 20mph is known.

**(ii) 20mph speed limit in the village.**

A request was made to CATG and this has been listed, 10 requests were made from the South West Wilts area. A small working group has been formed which will assess each request and these will be discussed at the next CATG meeting in May.

**(iii) Speed limit review in Skew Rd.**

The metrocount has been completed. CATG recommend no further action.  
To consider whether Quidhampton PC wish to pursue the matter further.

**(iv) Pedestrian safety issues in Skew Rd.**

**(v) Speeding along the A3094 between Park Wall traffic lights and the delimit sign.** An issue has been raised with the SWWAB concerning this. PC Pete has looked into the matter. The person raising the issue has not contacted the parish council.

**(vi) Update from the CATG meeting held on 10<sup>th</sup> March 2014.**

West St in Wilton to be resurfaced in June 2014.

Surfacing works along the A30 from Barford St Martin towards Ludwell in April.

Elite cycle race taking place 4<sup>th</sup> May 2014, this does not affect Quidhampton directly but there will be a rolling road closure on the day. The race starts at Wilton and travels along to A30 then into the Chalke Valley back to Wilton. It is also Salisbury Races that day.
