From 30 July you will be able to recycle:

- Plastic pots, tubs and trays
- Drink and food cartons

In addition to the usual plastic bottles and cardboard, you can include yoghurt pots, plastic trays, margarine tubs, ice cream tubs and juice, milk and soup cartons. These can all go in your blue lidded bin.

Please rinse and squash your recycling where possible.

Your questions answered..

1. Will my collection day change?

No, all your collections will still be fortnightly and your collection days will stay the same. Please remember to put your containers out by 7am on your collection day.

2. Will we get new bins?

No, please use the same containers that you already have. If you need extra recycling bins, please let us know.

3. What happens to my recycling once it is collected?

Your mixed recycling will be sent to a sorting facility where materials are separated from each other. If you put the wrong materials in your bin which cannot be recycled someone has to remove it by hand. The recycling is sent to be processed to be made into new products.
