

QUIDHAMPTON PARISH COUNCIL Councillor Vacancies



If you'd like to make a difference, and be involved in shaping the future of your local Community, why not step forward and apply to become a Parish Councillor?

You may apply provided you live within 3 miles of the Parish Council boundary. Persons applying for the role of Parish Councillor at application date must:

- 1) Be a British subject or a citizen of the Commonwealth or European Union
 - 2) Be 18 years of age or over
 - 3) Be able to meet at least one of the following qualifications:
 - i) have been registered as a local government elector for the Parish
 - ii) during the whole of the twelve months preceding the date of application, have occupied, as owner or tenant, land or premises in the Parish
 - iii) have had a principal or only place of work during the preceding twelve months in the Parish
 - iv) have resided within the Parish during the whole preceding twelve months or within 3 miles of its boundary.
 - 4) Not be disqualified from being a member of a Local Council under the Local Government Act 1972.
