- 2. **Approval of minutes** The minutes for the meeting held on Monday 25th October 2021 were approved.

3. Matters Arising

Ref item 3, BT had sent a village email on 27th Oct on the basis of Wiltshire Council's news release recommending distancing, masks in crowded or enclose areas and hygiene.

4. Chair

- HR highlighted that things change from tomorrow in view of the emergence of the Omicron variant. There was lack of data at present. A halfway mandatory measure was expected to be implemented by government for masks on transport and in shops. Omichron was known to be more contagious than Delta.
- The main message is to get a booster when you can.
- The White Horse was thought to be keeping in place its approach for mask wearing. **Action: BT** to check and send email
